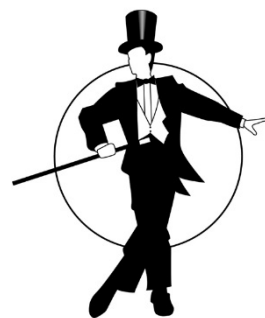


# Driving with Siri
